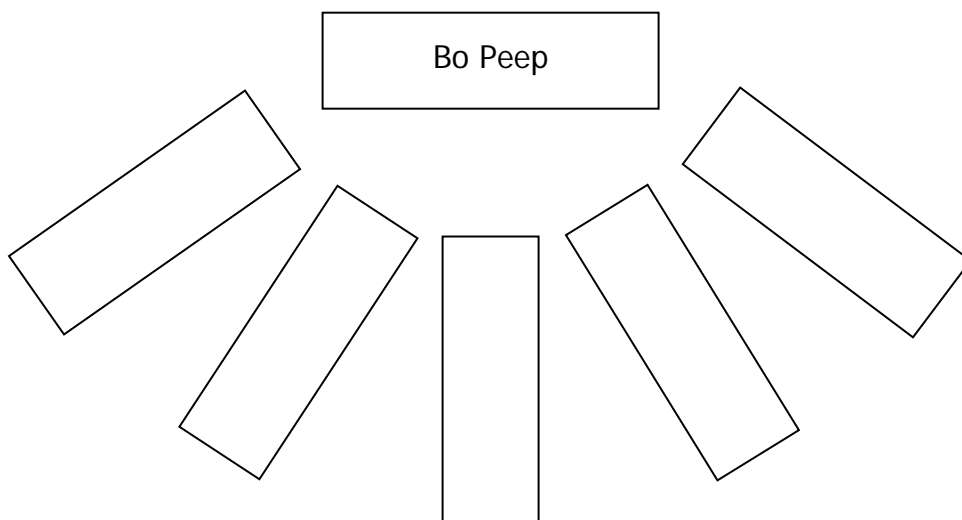
Reading Selection: Little Bo Peep
